- 1) The Arbitration Rules of the Arbitration Committee of the Bradford Chamber of Commerce & Industry are printed separately and will be supplied on request, and in any event will be sent to each party in acknowledging a completed submission to arbitration.
- 2) In the event of a party wishing the Arbitration Committee to undertake an Arbitration other than by means of obtaining his agreement in the form set out on the other side or some modification thereof such party should make a request in writing setting out the reasons why arbitration by the Arbitration Committee is requested. If there is in existence an agreement to submit all disputes to arbitration or an Order of the Court, these should be specifically mentioned and copies of the relevant documents should accompany the request. - 3) If a party wishes third or more parties to be joined he should give sufficient information as to his reasons to enable the Arbitration Committee to decide whether to invite such further parties to submit to arbitration.
